Section 17 to 20, 64 and 135, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **Fresh Beer Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at **576A Te Atatu Road, Te Atatu Peninsula, Auckland** and known as **Fresh Beer Brewing Company**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold on or delivered from the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) Alcohol may be sold on the premises only on the following days and during the following hours: Monday to Sunday 8.00am to 10.00pm
- (c) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers immediately adjacent to any alcohol that is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.
- (d) No intoxicated persons may be allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
- (e) Appropriate signage regarding the restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons must be prominently displayed at each entry, and adjacent to every point of sale.
- (f) The whole of the premises is designated as a **supervised** area.
- (g) The Host Responsibility Plan and Alcohol Management Plan that was submitted with the application must be complied with.
- (h) This licence is subject to the following undertaking: Fresh Beer Limited gives an undertaking that we will manufacture a minimum of 400L of beer under the Fresh Brew Co Brand.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licenses, this licence continues in force—

- (a) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed.

This licence expires at the close of 11 December 2025 unless renewed.
